**NOMINATION FOR THE POSITIONS OF PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, AND THREE OTHER MEMBERS TO THE COUNCIL OF CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF BANKERS, GHANA PURSUANT TO SECTION 4 OF THE CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF BANKERS GHANA ACT, 2019 (ACT 991) AND REGULATIONS 18, 19 AND 20 OF CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF BANKERS, GHANA REGULATIONS, 2021 (L.I. 2434)**

In accordance with section 4(2) of the Chartered Institute of Bankers Ghana, Act 2019 (Act 991) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) the Chartered Institute of Bankers, Ghana (hereinafter referred to as “the Institute”) is to be represented on the Council of the Institute by the following:

- (a) a chairperson who is the President of the Institute;
- (b) the Vice-President of the Institute;
- (g) the immediate past President of the Institute;
- (h) the Chief Executive Officer of the Institute; and
- (i) three members of the Institute elected by the members at an Annual General Meeting of the Institute at least two of whom are women.

Notice is hereby given that elections shall be conducted in accordance with regulation 18 of the Chartered Institute of Bankers, Ghana Regulations, 2021 (L.I. 2434) on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2026 to elect the following officers to the Council of the Institute:

- a President;
- a Vice President; and
- three (3) other members of the Institute, at least two of whom are women.

Interested members are advised to note the following provisions under Regulations 19 and 20 of the Chartered Institute of Bankers, Ghana Regulations, 2021 (L.I. 2434).

### **General Qualifications**

19. A member qualifies to be elected to the Council if the member
- a. is in good standing;
  - b. is a fit-and-proper person;
  - c. is a Chartered Banker;

- d. has a minimum of ten years post qualification experience; and
- e. serves or has served in a key management position.

**Qualification for President and Vice President**

20. Without limiting regulation 19, a person qualifies to be elected as President or Vice President of the Institute if the person

- a. serves or has served in an executive management position in a financial institution; and
- b. is a fellow of the Institute
